- » The Cisco logo has changed over the years, but always incorporated some graphic of the San Francisco Golden Gate Bridge:



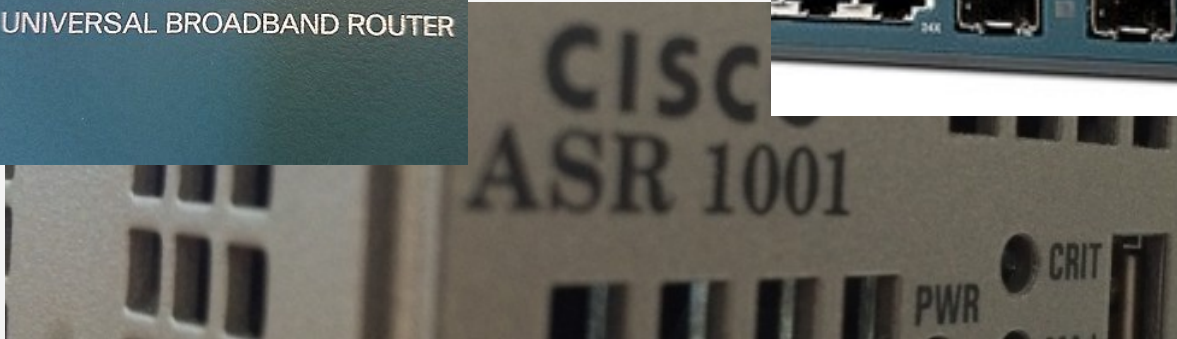
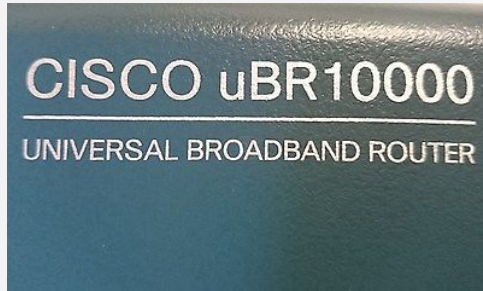
- » One of these logos will be present somewhere on the chassis of your Cisco device.

Identifying the Cisco Products



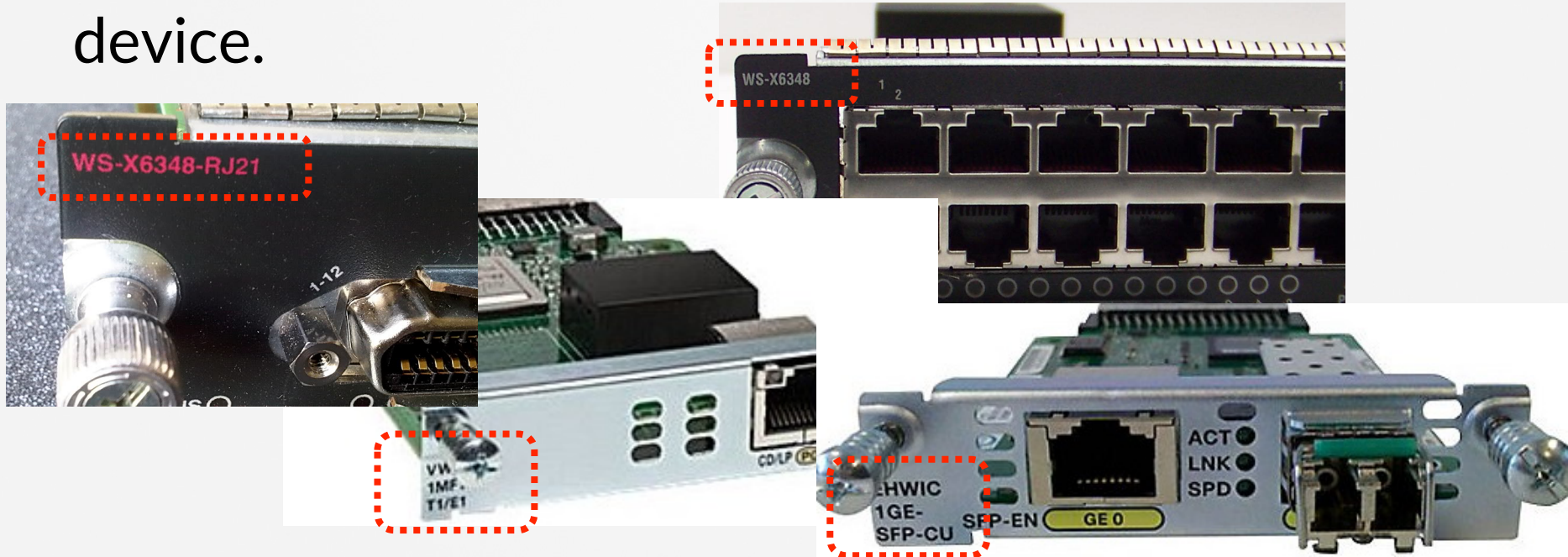
Identify Specific Model Number: Chassis

- » The model number of each device will be printed somewhere on the chassis of that device.



Identify Cisco product numbers of Linecards, Port Adapters or Network Modules

- » The part number of each linecard, port adapter, or network module will be printed somewhere on that device.
